

Pumpkin Succulent Planter Assembly and Care Instructions

ASSEMBLY:

Step 1:

Coat the top of the pumpkin with spray adhesive.

Step 2:

Before spray dries, press dry moss onto the top, create a layer $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1 inch thick.

Step 3:

Group 3 tallest items slightly to one side of center. Use clear craft glue to glue cuttings and seedpods to the moss. Work from center outward, packing items tightly.

Step 4:

Using a hot glue gun, attach items to moss. Rosettes that skirt the rim of the arrangement face outward.

Step 5:

Aim for a rounded arrangement, with initial items perpendicular to the top of the pumpkin, and shorter, smaller ones angled outward.

CARE OF PLANTER:

Protect it from harsh sun, excessive heat, freezing temp's, and rain.

Place on $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick piece of cardboard to keep moisture from collecting underneath.

Spritz plants once a week to moisten the moss and hydrate new little roots that might have formed. Avoid letting water pool around the stem of the squash/pumpkin.

Give it bright, indirect light and keep away from heaters.

To transition the planter to a more permanent home, slice off top and nestle the arrangement atop good soil in a pot and treat it as you would any other succulents.
